Two devastating months later we returned home from his stay in the hospital. I almost lost my husband multiple times due to numerous complications. Going from long days in the hospital to a confined motel room at night, was as bad as eating unhealthy meals for 60 days (x 3 meals), which became expensive. At times all the motels were previously booked, so I was forced to check out and slept in the hospital. None of these conditions are healthy for anyone's mental, emotional, and physical wellbeing. All of which I needed right then, most of all.*

*There is so much more to this two-month rollercoaster journey, that I could write a very intense book. However it would have a happy ending thanks to God. With prayers from everyone including strangers, along with superb doctors and staff, my husband was miraculously healed with two new heart valves. Feeling so blessed that my husband survived against all odds, I felt the need to give back. Through prayer, I realized I needed to offer out-of-town patients, their caregiver, and family something I didn't have... A Visitor's Haven. This had to be located near both hospitals so families can be with their loved one quickly, if urgently needed. I searched more than a year for that perfect Haven to fulfill a caregiver's and their recovering loved one's needs. And I knew exactly what those needs would be! Thanks to Joseph Zhao (the only committed-to-client realtor I experienced), on September 15, 2017 this 12-year old beautiful home became A Visitor's Haven. Now Joseph*
